Grisafi named to scholarship foundation board

Philip Grisafi has been elected to serve on the Board of Directors of the ConVal Community Scholarship Foundation Dollars for Scholars.

The foundation was organized in 2006 as a 501(c)(3) charitable organization, encouraged by community leaders to provide mentoring and scholarship assistance to seriously disadvantaged students residing in the ConVal region. Its mission statement is to "provide hope and confidence with community support to help more students in the ConVal region to achieve their potential."

Scholarship grants are given annually to six graduating seniors with two or more of these awards equal to half of the two-year tuition cost at N.H. community colleges. Winners are chosen on the basis of disadvantages overcome, desire to succeed and demonstrated potential for success. Post-high school progress of individual grant winners is monitored by foundation directors until completion of the programs for which awards are given.

Philip Grisafi is a senior vice president of Mosse and Mosse Associates Inc. He advises corporate clients in em-

He is a board member of the Greater Peterborough Chamber of Commerce, treasurer of the Monadnock Rotary Club and Peterborough Players, and is a member of the finance committee of the Union Congregational Church in Peterborough.
